01005597 In Central Asia, gender inequality remains deeply entrenched, with all five countries lagging on the Global Gender Gap Index and showing persistent disparities in women’s political representation, economic participation, and access to resources and opportunities. Against this backdrop, the 2026–2028 Multi-Country Programme (MCP) will apply a holistic, gender-transformative approach to address root causes of GBV and systemic gender inequality in all five Central Asian countries. UNDP component contributes to Outcome 3 across five Central Asian countries – Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan. It addresses the structural economic inequalities that increase women’s vulnerability to gender-based violence (GBV), including limited access to decent work, unequal labour market participation, and the disproportionate burden of unpaid care work. Through a regional approach led by UNDP Kazakhstan, the project will strengthen evidence-based policymaking and expand women’s economic opportunities. It will support gender-responsive data collection and analysis to inform policies addressing women’s economic vulnerabilities, while promoting women’s access to employment, entrepreneurship and sustainable livelihoods through partnerships with governments, civil society, academia and the private sector.
