Regarding the policy outputs, the project shifted discussions to Zoom, which has worked well. Regarding the PIC, annual reflection meeting to Donor, many discussions have happened by Zoom and phone call, with limited physical contact at the Government offices.							
Les	Lessons Learned							
	• Zoom is not always feasible for working on extremely technical pieces due to less face-to-face contact and unclear communication and individuals are required to collaborate in personas a result the project has used a designated working space, social distanced and with necessary precautions and cleaning tools, limited to two individuals per technical area for better feedback.
