Brief Description

Drawing on the experiences of REOPA and other innovative public works programmes aiming at permanently lifting extreme poor people out of poverty, SWAPNO will be a cash transfer project for women representing ultra-poor and vulnerable households. They will be engaged mainly in maintaining or rehabilitating important community assets but also in community service public works.

Women will within the employment tenure receive life skills and livelihoods skills training to ensure that the project serves purposes of both protection and promotion, making use of the transformative potential of social protection in reversing social exclusion and economic marginalization. Beneficiaries' graduation from the project to gainful future employment with diversified climate change resilient livelihoods options is the cornerstone of the project's graduation strategy. Women will be intensively counselled and supported to invest their cash transfer savings and expand the household asset base.

The project will also contribute to developing capacity of local government in managing social safety net projects and enhance good governance through pro-poor service delivery in support of livelihoods.

Justification for Budget Revision:

This AWP has been developed after consultation with stakeholders, importance of activities and in line with the activity plan developed for the donors through a rigorous planning workshop held in July'19.

In the year of 2020 the project has planned to utilize Sida fund by organizing skills development training (both life skills and livelihoods skills) to all women beneficiaries. Suitable training firm will organize the training which will cost about 0.43 million USD in total. 3 newly recruited NGOs will assist implementing the field activities throughout the year. They will be paid 0.32 million USD on quarterly basis. It is expected to include 600 women in formal sector employment. A lumpsum budget of USD 0.29 million USD is kept for this purpose. Micro-insurance study will be conducted this year with a budget of 0.06 million USD. Psychosocial counseling will be started in formal sector employees this year. Nutrition campaign along with BCC materials and seed distribution will be launched. Incorporating all operational and administrative expenses in the AWP, the volume stands at 2.47 million USD out of which Sida contribution is 2.24 million USD (91.17%). Marico has an unspent balance of USD 26,000 which will be utilized in Digital Financial Services and a collaboration project development in Satkhira. The regular TRAC fund amounted to USD 0.20 million USD will be used in programme monitoring, operation and administrative activities.

Strengthening Women's Ability for Productive New Opportunities (SWAPNO) annual programme review meeting held on 20 January 2019 at UNDP 18 Floor Conference Room. The following officials were attended the meeting:

- 3. Ms. Fatematul Jannat, Programme Associate, Planning and Reporting, Partnership and Business Development Cluster;
- 4. Mr. Kajal Chatterjee, National Project Manager, SWAPNO;

The meeting thoroughly reviewed the results of the project based on committed delivery and felt deep satisfaction. The total delivery was 91 percent (USD 1,045,745) against the revised target set in October after delivery clinic. The AWP 2019 target was set for US\$ 1,148,817. The meeting reviewed the SIDA provision along with unspent balance of MARICO fund to implement the planned activities as per SIDA proposal and agreed to provide adequate TRAC Fund for project operation and administrative expenses for the year. The meeting had also discussed the prospects of UNDP's engagement and interest of donors and their future business case. The meeting decided upon the following budget proposal with TRAC allocation for 2020:
