1. Duration of the Project

The Project will be extended due to activities planned within Components 1 and 4. Therefore the start date of the Project will remain the same – November 1, 2013 and the end date will be changed from December 31, 2016 to December 31, 2017.

2. Total resources allocated

The allocated resources are increased in the total amount of 183,375 USD from the following sources of funding:

- 35,000 USD from the UNDP MNE core resources (TRAC),
- 148,375 USD from the Delivering Results Together Fund (DRTF).
