Brief Project Description

In 2019, UNDP initiated the support to the MoH through the 'Health System Strengthening' (HSS) Programme, funded by the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria and implemented through a financing agreement signed with the Ministry of Health on the 22 February 2019.

The implementation of the Programme involved the preparation for the construction of health infrastructures in 5 provinces for improved medical supply chain system management and improved conditions of clinical care for multi-drug resistant Tuberculosis patients. It also contributed to step up the fight against impact of climate change on health with intervention in provinces affected by cyclone IDAI.

UNDP resorted to its sub-regional experience to provide support to the Government of Mozambique. The innovations included in the different health Infrastructures Executive Projects and validated by the MoH ensure that the epidemiological aspects are considered, promoting a safe environment for hospitalization and eliminating the risk of propagation of the diseases.

The construction of 5 Wards for multi-drug resistant Tuberculosis patients and 17 Waiting shelters in the TB clinics ensure healthier conditions for the patients, provide better working environment for the health workers and reduce the burden for patients and relatives while waiting for treatment. As a result, the conditions of clinical care of multi-drug resistant Tuberculosis patients are to improve and, by improving the clinical care conditions, it is expected that infections reduce and that multi-drug resistant Tuberculosis patients are less reluctant to undergo treatment and, consequently, multi-drug resistant Tuberculosis treatment outcome is enhanced.
