By arrangement dated **21 November 2017**, I awarded your organisation a contribution not exceeding **USD 1,000,000.-** for the project '**Supporting the Tunisian population's access to their rights**'.

By letter of **25 November 2019**, you requested a no-cost extension of the project period until 31 December 2021 for the abovementioned project.

I am willing to make the following changes to the arrangement:

The period will run from **1 October 2017 to 31 December 2021**.

Article 1:

*Payment Schedule:*

A second installment of USD 250,000.- will be transferred in the first quarter of 2020, after receipt of a request for payment in which the liquidity need is substantiated. The third installment of USD 250,000.- will be transferred in the first quarter of 2021 after receipt of a request for payment in which the liquidity need is substantiated.

Thank you for submitting the narrative report for the period until June 2019. I am pleased to inform you that the report has been approved.


