Brief Description

This cover sheet certifies the extension of the project "Single Window for Export-Import Operations".

Taking into account the inclusion of the Ministry of Adalat of Turkmenistan and the State Committee on Statistics of Turkmenistan, as well as the newly reorganized Ministry of Environmental Protection of Turkmenistan, as the new partners in the "Single Window for Export-Import Operations" project, as well as the need for additional time for their high-quality integration into the "Single Window" system for export-import transactions" and integration with existing information systems used by other government regulatory authorities;

In addition, considering the need to support the operation and maintenance of the Single Window for Export-Import Transactions system and the need for high-quality implementation and operation of the Single Window for Export-Import Operations system, it was decided to:

- To extend the Project Document until December 31, 2024, in order to ensure effective completion of all activities planned under the project without increasing the cost of the project.
- revise the Project Document, including the Partnership, and the 2024 Work Plans and the Results Framework (attached).
- to keep other terms and conditions of the Project Document unchanged.


