


**Brief Description**

The rapidly aging population is one of the predominant problems in China. Currently, social support pressure is relatively huge and the social security system in China is facing more severe challenges in the future with the aging population. Despite the fact that the elderly care or pension sector has been categorized as the state key project in China's 13th Five-Year Plan, there remain huge gaps for China in a multi-level elderly care service system in terms of policy/regulations, standards, capacity and availability of liveable elderly care communities.

Through the implementation of the pilot project in Lianhuashan District of Changchun City, one of China's oldest industrial bases since 1949, a liveable elderly care community will be built with activities designed for policy/regulation support, capacity development, demonstration of innovative technologies concepts and holding regular international/national level forums/conferences; Such a liveable elderly care community pilot in turn will facilitate the development of a sound elderly care system for the City of Changchun while at the same time contributing to the development of a sustainable elderly care model for North-East Asia, and eventually contributing to the achievement of the **SDG #3: Good Health and Wellbeing**.

**Outcome 1: Develop and finalize Project Document for full size project**

### **Expected Results for Full Size Project**

**Outcome 1: A detailed layout of a new liveable elderly care community in Lianhuashan District designed and an *Overall Development Plan* for the Elderly Care Sector in Changchun City developed**

Activity 1.1: to conduct baseline survey on the status of the rural communities in Lianhuashan District and the elderly care sector in Changchun

Activity 1.2: to conduct case study on the best practices of the domestic elderly care sector, including but not limited to HK, Beijing, Shanghai, Zhejiang, Sichuan and Hannan

Activity 1.3: to conduct case study on the best practices of the elderly care sector overseas, including but not limited to North-East and South-East Asia, North America, and EU

Activity 1.4: Proposing policy recommendations and developing regulations and/or standards for the sustainable development of the elderly care sector in Changchun City

Activity 1.5: To draft detailed development plans for setting up cross-climate-zone elderly care service chain for the elderly care sector in Changchun City, which will also be based on for piloting a liveable elderly care community for the North-Eastern Asia

**Outcome 2: Capacity building for the elderly care sector in Changchun City**

Activity 2.1: To improve and/or draft new standards and regulations on the elderly care sector by reviewing existing policies and regulations in Changchun and in China

Activity 2.2: To set up a sustainable vocational training and certification system for the elderly care sector in Changchun City with inclusion of the indigenous people in Lianhuashan

Activity 2.3: To create a medical-resources sharing platform in Changchun, including 1) adoption into the elderly care sector of Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) theories and techniques; 2) establishment of remote-diagnostic system; and 3) cross-climate-zone elderly care service chain

**Outcome 3: Innovative technologies and concept piloted for setting up a sustainable elderly care model for Changchun City and NE Asia**

Activity 3.1: To pilot the application of new technologies for energy-efficient building, power generation, heating, transportation, waste management for a liveable elderly care community

Activity 3.2: To introduce advanced medical equipment from overseas for creating a liveable elderly care community

Activity 3.3: To showcase the application of the concept of health improving/maintaining and cost offsetting through regular and proactive employment in the organic farming in the elderly care community

**Outcome 4: Advocacy and Promotion**

Activity 4.1: To advocate an inclusive elderly care community concept with Chinese characteristics

Activity 4.2: To organize national level conference annually to promote the sustainable development of the elderly care sector and adoption of TCM in the elderly care sector

Activity 4.3: To launch the Bi-annual NE Asia Elderly Care Summit to help achieve the UN SDG #3: Good Health and Wellbeing
