Greetings from FBA team.

We have below case from Honduras CO. The issue is that expenses made by other agencies (like UNOPS) are not recorded in CDR column "UN Agencies exp". To my understanding in order to have these expenses recorded under relevant Agency column, they should be processed through GLJE, using analysis type "PDE" (office signs UN to UN agreement, then UNOPS contacts GSSC agencies team, GSSC processes advance to UNOPS, UNOPS quarterly submits PDRs to GSSC, GSSC creates GLJE using PDE). However, HND CO processed both advances and recoveries through AP module (under HND10 BU, details are in the attached AAA report). Therefore no one dollar expense is recorded as Agency payment.

Based on above could you please clarify whether RBLAC country offices (including Honduras CO) have been fully clustered for this type of payments (advances to UN agencies and submission of PDRs).

2022-06-16 15:58:48 - Branka ZELENBABA - Dear Claudia, We further reviewed reported issue with my colleague here and noted the following: Please refer to the attached screenshot and note that query UN_KK_TRANS DETAIL shows the amount that corresponds to the amount shown as unfunded in the budget cover page. It appears that GLJE was entered in 2022 using budget date of 2021 hence the difference. If it was a GLJE entered based on OFRM request, you may follow up with colleagues in order to clear (reverse) the

amount. However, please check with OFRM before. Also please note that reconciliation between GL and KK sometime shows differences due to different factors affecting two different platforms. It can be: Conceptual: GL shows the expenses while KK shows the Used funds. Typical example is when buying an asset (i.e. a vehicle) If I buy a car as asset in GL it will be recorded as asset to 18xxx accounts, while I did use those funds so KK will show this as expense. Budget Date vs Accountings Date: GL works based on the fiscal year which is the accounting date, while KK works based on Budget Date. If I prepare a PO voucher from a previous year PO, as the funds were already committed previous year, the KK will show that voucher in the same year (same budget date) as the PO was raised. Timing difference: KK is only (as soon as transactions is Valid) while GL is posted frequently but not official until closed period. Finally, I was informed that it was noted there is a difference between Atlas CDR and CDR from Bridge that happened this year.
