Spotlight regional programme supports the countries of Central Asia in implementation of international standards for prevention and response to gender-based violence through studies, tools and capacity-building workshops for relevant ministries, security sector, and civil society representatives. The programme addresses specific legislative, policy and institutional gaps in prevention, protection, and multi-sectoral response to SGBV, provision of quality services for survivors and improving the
