Estos recursos provienen del Global Programme on Strengthening the Rule of Law and Human Rights for Sustaining Peace and Fostering Development de la sede del PNUD.

Actualmente el proyecto apalancó recursos con el Gobierno de Noruega por USD\$50.000, para apoyar el output 2 del proyecto (Toars), y se esperan a futuro para el 2022 apalancar más recursos.
