QUESTION 1: How Does the Portfolio MYWP/Project Integrate the Programming Principles in Order to Strengthen Social and Environmental Sustainability?

Briefly describe in the space below how the portfolio MYWP/project mainstreams the human rights-based approach (32000 Characters maximum)

El programa fue diseñado mediante un proceso participativo que involucró activamente tanto a Organizaciones de Personas con Discapacidad como a personas con discapacidad, quienes participaron de manera significativa en la identificación de las principales brechas existentes. Entre estas, se destacó la ausencia de una evaluación nacional de personas con discapacidad y de un sistema de certificación como una de las principales barreras para el acceso a servicios esenciales, en particular a las redes de protección social y a los mecanismos de seguridad social.

Asimismo, a lo largo de la implementación del proyecto, se garantizaron espacios continuos de participación y consulta que permitieron mantener el involucramiento sostenido de las organizaciones y de las personas con discapacidad, en coherencia con los principios de la Convención sobre los Derechos de las Personas con Discapacidad, especialmente en lo relativo a la participación plena y efectiva en los asuntos que les conciernen.

En esta fase final, el proyecto ha priorizado a las personas con discapacidad desde un enfoque interseccional, con especial énfasis en las mujeres con diferentes tipos de discapacidades que residen en departamentos alejados de los centros urbanos. Esta perspectiva ha permitido abordar de manera específica las múltiples desigualdades que enfrentan, particularmente aquellas relacionadas con barreras de movilidad y limitaciones económicas, lo que permitirá en algún momento el acceso al proceso de certificación biopsicosocial y contribuyendo a su empoderamiento y a la reducción de brechas de género.

Briefly describe in the space below how the portfolio MYWP/project mainstreams sustainability and resilience (32000 Characters maximum)

Si bien el proyecto no tiene un enfoque ambiental directo, incorpora principios de sostenibilidad y resiliencia institucional a través de la optimización de procesos y el uso de herramientas digitales. Un ejemplo concreto es la implementación de la plataforma virtual utilizada por el Ministerio de Salud y Asistencia Social para el proceso de certificación biopsicosocial, lo cual reduce significativamente el uso de papel y otros insumos físicos asociados (como tinta), contribuyendo a la disminución de residuos no reciclables. A mediano y largo plazo, esta digitalización fortalece la sostenibilidad del sistema, promueve un uso más eficiente de los recursos y mejora la resiliencia institucional frente a limitaciones logísticas y operativas, garantizando la continuidad y escalabilidad del servicio.

Briefly describe in the space below how the portfolio MYWP/project strengthens accountability to stakeholders (32000 Characters maximum)

El proyecto ha fortalecido la rendición de cuentas hacia las principales partes interesadas mediante el acompañamiento técnico al Ministerio de Salud y Asistencia Social (MSPAS) y al Consejo Nacional de Atención a las Personas con Discapacidad (CONADI), dos actores clave en la garantía de derechos de las personas con discapacidad. En el caso del MSPAS, el apoyo técnico ha reforzado su rol como ente responsable del proceso de certificación de la discapacidad, contribuyendo a la implementación de mecanismos claros, estandarizados y transparentes. Por su parte, el acompañamiento al CONADI se ha realizado desde una perspectiva diferenciada, reconociendo su función como principal referente institucional al que acuden las personas con discapacidad para la orientación y exigibilidad de sus derechos, con especial atención a aquellas que residen en comunidades alejadas. Asimismo, el fortalecimiento del sistema de recopilación y gestión de datos derivados de las certificaciones permite a CONADI disponer de información confiable para la formulación de políticas públicas y planes gubernamentales basados en evidencia, reforzando así la transparencia, la responsabilidad institucional y la toma de decisiones informada en beneficio de la población con discapacidad.
