Briefly describe in the space below how the portfolio MYWP/project mainstreams the human rights-based approach (32000 Characters maximum)

La violencia contra las mujeres y niñas (VCMN), representa un gran obstáculo para el desarrollo del país que, además de impedir el disfrute pleno de los derechos humanos de las mujeres, afecta directamente en la salud pública, y genera impactos negativos tanto económicos como sociales. Es por tanto que, este proyecto tiene como principal objetivo procurar el derecho internacional y nacional de reconocer el derecho a una vida libre de violencia como aquel derecho de las mujeres a que ninguna acción u omisión, basada en el género, cause daño o sufrimiento psicológico, físico, patrimonial, económico, sexual o la muerte tanto en el ámbito privado como en el público. Sin embargo, de acuerdo con la Cuarta Conferencia Mundial sobre la Mujer en 1995 (donde se redactó la Declaración de Beijing) los hombres pueden y deben ser parte de la solución a la desigualdad de género, siendo, históricamente, los principales perpetuadores de esta violencia. Por tanto, este proyecto busca procurar este derecho a través de la promoción de las masculinidades no violentas y corresponsables en México, así como desafiar las normas sociales que perpetúan la desigualdad y discriminación hacia las mujeres. Asimismo, a partir de que el proyecto se enfoca en el trabajo con hombres indígenas y afromexicanos, la sostenibilidad social y ambiental es un factor muy importante en la implementación de las actividades en campo para asegurar un ambiente seguro y sano y la plena participación en las decisiones que conlleve el adoptar los programas propuestos por las organizaciones para que no afecten sus territorios.

Briefly describe in the space below how the portfolio MYWP/project is likely to improve gender equality and women's empowerment (32000 Characters maximum)

El objetivo del proyecto es lograr la igualdad de género y el empoderamiento de las mujeres afrontando la violencia, un flagelo que impide a las mujeres tener una vida digna, mediante la implementación de un programa piloto en México para la transformación de masculinidades nocivas. El programa implicará el desarrollo de capacidades y promoción de masculinidades no violentas y corresponsables en instituciones públicas, Organizaciones de la sociedad civil (OSC), y organizaciones comunitarias, con énfasis en trabajo con hombres indígenas y afromexicanos.

El proyecto se centra en 3 estrategias principales:

1. Identificar prácticas para la promoción de masculinidades positivas, no violentas y corresponsables; a partir de lo cual se seleccionarán experiencias de OSC y organizaciones

- comunitarias, enfocadas principalmente en trabajo con hombres indígenas y afromexicanos, para su revisión y posterior reconocimiento y difusión por medio de talleres dirigidos por el PNUD, UNFPA y ONU Mujeres y publicación de un informe nacional.
2. Realizar una convocatoria pública para seleccionar al menos cinco organizaciones de la sociedad civil y comunitaria de hombres indígenas y afromexicanos, para trabajar en un proceso de desarrollo de capacidades y promoción de masculinidades positivas, no violentas y corresponsables en sus organizaciones o comunidades.
3. Con base en la experiencia en el campo y el desarrollo de la Teoría de Cambio revisada, diseñar e implementar un conjunto de módulos de desarrollo de capacidades sobre masculinidades positivas, no violentas y corresponsables con enfoque interseccional, dirigidos a organizaciones de la sociedad civil que trabajan masculinidades con enfoque feminista, así como al funcionariado de la administración pública, con especial atención a las instituciones más masculinizadas como las fuerzas de defensa, policía y seguridad

Briefly describe in the space below how the portfolio MYWP/project mainstreams sustainability and resilience (32000 Characters maximum)

La eliminación de la violencia contra las mujeres y las niñas se ha incorporado a los Objetivos de Desarrollo Sostenible (ODS) de la Agenda 2030, concretamente en las metas 5.2 y 5.3 del ODS 5 sobre igualdad de género como parte de una acción que afecta los resultados en otras áreas para equilibrar la sostenibilidad social, económica y ambiental para garantizar la paz y prosperidad. Asimismo, reconociendo que la violencia es un factor que impide el total disfrute de los derechos de las mujeres, que, para el caso de las mujeres indígenas, se encuentra estrechamente vinculada con las formas continuas e interseccionales de discriminación que enfrentan, su posición es aún más vulnerable frente al resto de la población. Por lo tanto, el trabajo en campo de las organizaciones con enfoque de género, intercultural, interseccional y de Derechos Humanos permitirá fortalecer las capacidades para beneficio de toda la comunidad, con base en la sostenibilidad y resiliencia ante las consecuencias negativas de la violencia contra las mujeres.
