Brief Description
This cover page certifies the extension of the project “Assistance in capacity building of the Central Commission for Holding Elections and Referendums in Turkmenistan”. On 12 January 2026, Mrs. Rosemary A. DiCarlo, Under-Secretary-General for Political and Peacebuilding Affairs (DPA) and United Nations Focal Point for Electoral Assistance Matters, approved the Desk Review recommendations, and extended the mandate of the project until June 2027, which is the period that is valid for both finalization of the current project and preparation and implementation of the new projects. At the request of the Turkmen side, the following decision has been made: - To forward the recommendations to the Central Commission for Holding Elections and Referendums in Turkmenistan (CEC) via Note Verbale; - To prepare the Project Document reflecting these recommendations and obtain the necessary endorsements for the project document from the DPA and the CEC. - Based on the extension of UNDP's mandate to provide support to CEC, the current project should be extended by the 30th of March 2026 to allow for the timely utilization of unspent project balance resulting from savings from the project. - To conduct the procurement of the equipment, adding to the result of Activity 2.2. (list agreed with CEC) from the remaining balance of the project budget and transfer the equipment to the CEC by the 30th of March 2026. The remaining terms, conditions and clauses of the Project Document remain unchanged.
