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2: Communication with Israeli Coordination Liaison Administration (CLA) during March 2019

On 24 March 2018, the Government of Israel (GoI) announced the closure of Gaza Crossings including Kerem Shalom starting from 25 March 2019 and until further notice. As well, Kerem Shalom was closed on 21 March 2019 because of Purim holiday. The tightening has been removed and Kerem Shalom re-opened on 31 March 2019.

As part of the underlying communication mechanism between UNDP Access Project and the CLA, there is monthly meeting to discuss the UNDP pending applications, on-going issues and matters concerns. The planned meeting for March 2019 was conducted on 3 April 2019 and the UNDP team was led by Ahmad Al Hammal, Operations and Services Manager.

UNDP team demonstrated presentation regarding the pending applications, particularly project number GP-10032 for Construction of Main Influent Pressure Line from Existing GRP Pipe to Khan Younis Waste Water Treatment Plant (KY WWTP) - UNDP Package 5. And all the pending issues regarding staff permits were tackled at the meeting.

Moreover, during the month of March 2019, the access project has managed to clear and approved the following UNDP pending applications from CLA and Israeli Tele-communication Department:

- Application number 704447: of Fiber & Control Cables for project (GP-10074) C.5.1 Construction of Khan Younis Waste Water Treatment Plant & Buildings (KY WWTP) (Package 1), was approved from David Cohen Office on 10 March 2019, expired on 09 May 2019
- Application number 715670: of Transformer 630 KVA for project C.5.4 Construction of the Electrical Power Supply to the WWTP Package number four of Khan Younis Waste Water Treatment Plant, was approved from David Cohen Office on 20 March 2019, expired on 19 May 2019

3: Total Received Materials into Gaza since January 2011 and up to 31 March 2019

Since the establishment of Access Coordination and Monitoring Support Project (ACMSP) and up to end of March 2019, the Access Team has managed to coordinate and receive a total of <u>264,627.21 Tons</u> in addition to the load of <u>516 Trucks</u> (total 7,111 Trucks) of different construction materials and miscellaneous items dispersed between various types as per the following table and chart:

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4: Summary of Projects Supported by ACMSP from 2011 up to 31 March 2019

As of 31 March 2019, the access project managed to receive COGAT/CLA approvals for 187 projects with a total value more than USD 290.5 million. The coordinated materials have injected life into a total of 186 different projects, serving different sectors and various units, with a value of USD 290 million (On-going and Completed Projects). Out of this number, 178 projects with value of USD 224.3 million were completed and handed over to final beneficiaries through the coordinated materials (Completed Projects). While 8 projects with value of USD 65.8 million are still on-going, and relevant coordination are still under process. One project with total value of USD 300,000 are still under design and/or tendering stages, and their necessary coordination shall start once the projects are awarded. The following table shows a snapshot of status and values of these projects.
