Overview of National GPAR Programme Secretariat Support Project Plans for 2013

The *National GPAR Programme Secretariat Support Project (GPAR NGPS)* supports the Government to implement and monitor the National Governance and Public Administration Reform Programme (NGPAR Programme). The overall objective of this project is to strengthen the capacity of public administration to deliver efficient, effective and accountable services to citizens through high level oversight and leadership, strategic management and support to all components of the national GPAR Programme in Lao PDR.

The GPAR Secretariat Project is organized around three outputs. The first output is to support the establishment of high level mechanisms that provide oversight and coordination across the governance sector. The second output is to strengthen the capacity of the Ministry of Home Affairs to effectively coordinate and monitor the implementation of the National GPAR Programme and related activities. The third output is support the coordination of development partners assistance through the Governance Sector Working Group, and mobilize resources to support the implementation of the National GPAR Programme.

During 2013, the National GPAR Secretariat Project will build on the groundwork made in 2012 to further enhance high level monitoring of governance initiatives and Government-development partners dialogue and coordination especially on emerging issues. This is to further advance and deepen the implementation of the governance reforms in Lao PDR. In relation to Output 1, the project will support the Leading Committee on Governance track the progress of implementation of the Strategic Plan on Governance and the implementation of PM Order #16.

In relation to Output 2, the project will support the continued capacity development of MoHA through the conduct of capacity development training on programme finance, result-based management and related areas. Capacity building support will be provided to enable key MoHA personnel to take on programme management responsibilities. The recruitment of additional staff and procurement of basic equipment will also be carried out during the year. The project will also, during the year, develop and implement a communications and outreach strategy, to enable more systematic dissemination of information related to the progress and achievements of the National GPAR Programme, the activities of the Leading Committee on Governance and the Governance Sector Group/Sub-sector working. This is to enhance public awareness, understanding and promote greater national ownership of the Government's governance and public administration reform.

Activities under Output 3 will reflect continuity and mainstreaming of on-going efforts related to the Governance Sector Working Group (GSWG). However, an important part of the effort will be to review and streamline the scope of the GSWG work plan to enable it to focus on the emerging and strategic issues that impact on the effectiveness of the implementation of governance reforms. The GPAR Programme Secretariat project will support the GSWG preparation and participation in the Round Table Meeting, identify opportunities for resource mobilization efforts to address the unfunded components of current projects, and complete the formulation and launch the upcoming EU-UNDP Project under the National GPAR Programme.
