1. Project Implementation Status and Key Results

Implementation Status Summary at Outcome level *(This needs to be completed by project)*

In Quarter 3 of 2015, the NRA has continued to perform its important role in the UXO sector, coordinating, regulating and monitoring the work of UXO sector operators¹, and has contributed to maximizing the performance of the Sector as a whole. The NRA continues to assist the Government in achieving the UNDAF outcome, in a manner consistent with the Safe Path Forward II (SPF II) and that advances progress toward MDG 9).

In Q3, NRA and UNDP looked at the planning of the KOICA supported project. US\$1.6m is allocated from that project for 2015, and several activities are planned including large procurement of equipment and services for VA. So far, we have received the transfer from KOICA to the Trust Fund UNDP bank account already.

A charity golf tournament held at the Km4 Golf Club in Vientiane on Saturday raised more than 100 million Lao Kip (approximately US\$12,300) for the rehabilitation of UXO victims in Laos. More than 200 golfers took part. The tournament was also attended by the Deputy Prime Minister and the Minister of Education and Sport, as well as senior officials from ministries. The competition was conceived as a way of raising money from businesses and individuals to fund activities to help and treat UXO victims. In addition, the tournament also served to boost friendship among golfers whilst celebrating the 60th anniversary of the founding of the Lao People's Revolutionary Party and the 40th anniversary of the Lao PDR.

The NRA encourages operators to coordinate with the education department in contaminated provinces and districts, before conducting MRE activities in schools. During Q3 of 2015, the number of accidents reached 4 accidents with total of 6 victims, of whom 4 people were injured (1 boy and 3 men) and 2 people were killed (1 man and 1 woman).

During the third quarter of 2015, a total of 521 Ha of land was cleared (interim figures as of 30 September 2015); including 404 Ha of agricultural land and 117 Ha of development land. During Q3 of 2015, operators in Lao PDR destroyed more than 12,109 items of UXO, of which 17 were bombs, 7,802 were bombies, 8 were mines, and 4,282 were other UXO items.
