1. Project Implementation Status and Key Results

1.1. Outcome Level Progress

This project aims at increasing the capacity of the UXO sector in Lao PDR to deal with the problem of remaining unexploded ordnance in order to reduce the humanitarian threat and the remove barriers to productive and sustainable use of land. At the outcome-level, it can be reported that a number of changes have occurred between 01 January to 31 March 2017 (Q1).

- The number of reported casualties during Q1 was 22 of which 21 were injuries (11 woman); and 1 death (woman) resulting from a total of 6 accidents. While last quarter (Q4) the total number of accidents was 3. The number of casualties during that period was 6, of which 5 were injuries (0 women) and 1 death (man).
- In accordance with the approval of new survey procedures for UXO by the Government of Lao PDR, all humanitarian operators in the Lao PDR now employ the evidence-based approach to land clearance. Applying this new approach has increased the number of Cluster Munition (CM) found per hectare. As it can be reported that the number of CM found per hectare cleared in Q1 was in average of 19 items, while the number of CM found per hectare was 5 and 21 items in 2014 and 2016 respectively. The number of Cluster Munitions found per hectare is summarized in the following table, which gives the breakdown by province and month to demonstrate the general trend in improving performance.

1.2. UNDP's Contribution

During the reporting period, UNDP has supported the management and technical capacity-building of UXO Lao. In doing so, UNDP finance has contributed to all output and outcome-level achievements attributable to the sector. Since 2014, UNDP has committed to taking a comprehensive and sectoral

approach, which is evident in the types of technical deployments preferred. In terms of the specific support provided, some of the key elements can be summarized as follows:

- a. Technical Advice During Q1, UNDP's finance technical specialist has assisted UXO Lao's finance team allocating fund in UXO Lao Annual Work Plan and revised audit notes as well as assisted in the regular basis on financial report.
- b. Management and Procurement UNDP has also supported UXO Lao in their procurement of equipment necessary to manage and undertake UXO-related activities. In Q1, UNDP supported in procuring vary items.

With the present of financial specialist, UNDP also supports UXO Lao with quarterly financial monitoring, contracting for yearly external audits, and provision of a coordination mechanism for contributing Development Partners.

- c. Sector Leadership UNDP has provided substantial support to get UXO staff attend trainings or workshops related to leadership capacity building when they are available. During the reporting period, the director of UXO Lao attended the 20th International Meeting of Mine Action National Program Directors and United Nations Advisors. The theme of the meeting focused on humanitarian needs, humanitarian emergencies and humanitarian responses, which was conducted from 7 to 10 February 2017 in Geneva, Switzerland.
- d. Capacity Building UNDP has continuously supported UXO Lao to work on new format of Annual Work Plan and its revised as well as ways to manage fund accordance to the given budget line. On the regular basis, UNDP's financial specialist works together with UXO Lao finance unit in HQ to follow up on the grant management and provide assistance as the requirement and appropriateness.
- e. Resource Mobilization UNDP has been instrumental in engaging new and previous donors in financing the UXO sector. This has led to the negotiation with the current donor in providing additional fund for unfunded province and training center. In Q1 UNDP was able to provide that advance funding to be utilized in UXO Lao Luangprabang while UXO Lao Langprabang was waiting for the funding approval from Norway.

1.3. Output Level Achievements

The Output-level achievements of the project during the reporting period are summarized in the tables below. The most notable achievements by UXO Lao include:

- Cleared Confirmed Hazardous Areas (CHA) and areas for development projects identified by UXO
 Lao covering of 989.7 hectares of land.
- Completed 139 mine risk education village visits in the nine highly-contaminated provinces.
- 46 villages were completely conducted Non-technical survey.
- 2,363.6 hectares of new CHA were established.

- The teams funded by Australian Government in 3 provinces, Savannakhet, Salavan and Champasak, were able to achieve 52.5 hectares of clearance and 866 UXO items found and destroyed.
- The Director of UXO Lao, Thipphasone Soukathammavong, attended the 20th International Meeting of Mine Action National Programme Directors and United Nations Advisors that is conducted on the annual basis in Geneva. The annual meeting was jointly organised by the United Nations Inter-Agency Coordination Group on Mine Action (IACG-MA) and the Geneva International Centre for Humanitarian Demining (GICHD). It provided an opportunity for members of the mine action community to meet and share the progress and challenges within the sector. Most of participants were senior officials who came from various organizations and institutions. This included participants from mine action programmes, colleagues from United Nations departments and agencies, representatives from non-governmental organisations, humanitarian institutions, research organisations and experts from donor governments and other mine action implementing partners
- Joint Coordination Committee (JCC) meetings is a joint meeting that involved representatives from UXO Lao HQ, UXO Lao Salavan, UXO Lao Sekong, UXO Lao Champasack, JICA HQ and JICA Lao. The meeting is conducted annually under the support of JICA on areas prioritization planning pilot project. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss on the previous year of the operational outcomes and ways to improve the management capacity of UXO Lao on task prioritization. On 14 March 2017, JCC was conducted at UXO Lao office with a total number of 29 participants (10 females). At the meeting all parties agreed that pilot project of prioritization planning process in Salavan and Sekong will start in May 2017, in which will apply the same procedure as Champasak in 2016. UXO Lao HQ team and JICA as well as UXO Lao Champasak will provide a full support in applying the format in prioritizing the task to the annual plan.
- During the reporting period, 3 trainings of EOD1 for additional 15 teams were conducted at UXO Lao Khammuane, Savanakhet and Attapeu. The total participants were 140 people. The training took place between 23 January and 17 February 2017. These additional 15 teams are financed by the US through Sterling International Group.

3. Project Management and Oversight

3.1 Monitoring and Evaluation

During the reporting period, three provinces (Luangpabang, Huaphan and Xiengkhuang) were visited by Program and Public Information Unit. Overall, it can be seen that the field work has been improved in terms of field reporting. The team leaders and section commanders have better understanding of the new concept of operation. During the visit, PO/PI team has requested respective provinces to share significant events and news to be disseminated through website and facebook pages.

3.2 Risk Management

In Q1, 2017 report, 7 risks were identified. One of the risks, funding gap, has not been changed much particularly UXO Lao Training Center and Luangpabang province. On this stage, UNDP and UXO are working on collaboratively on fund raising. The second identified risk was the delay of the new project document approval. This can impact the overall operation in Q2 which may result in low productivity. Third, MRE activity has confronted the lack of support in terms of funding. Developing the concept of MRE to comply with new concept of operation might help to overcome this. Forth, lack of explosive has been prevented field operation to achieve the target. Fifth, climate change is unpredictable, UXO Lao staff has to adapt to the weather while implementing. Seventh, the changes from request based to the survey-based clearance needs to emphasize because communities have got used to the previous implementation system. Time is needed for the community to understand the new concept of operation. Lastly, harms during clearance task need to be carefully monitored and ensured that the implementation is complied with SOPs.

3.3 Communication and Advocacy

During the reporting period, only regular press release (via UXO Lao website and Facebook) was implemented.

3.4 Management Responses and Recommendations

 During the reporting period, there were three auditing companies conducted the internal audit of UXO Lao. UXO Lao is waiting for those audit reports.

Field operational assessment (AWP 6.7)

- Lack of funding results in insufficient medical equipment, and unofficial training for medics (however, new medic staff are experienced staff).
- Immediate resignation of field staff particularly team leaders and section commanders have resulted in improper training provided to EOD3 and EOD2 to replace the absence position of team leaders and section commanders respectively. QM unit raised this issue to HR unit for further action.
- The record of UXO coordinates was inaccurate. SEOD was suggested to closely monitor and provide the supervision as needed to ensure that the field work meets the standard of operation.

External Audit by The Board of Audit of Japan:

On 20 to 23 February, the projects of UXO Lao under the Embassy of Japan's Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects were audited by the Board of Audit of Japan. The audit

was mainly focus on field equipment in Champasack province and the rebuilding of the UXO Lao training center in Vientiane.

Recruitment:

In Q1 2017, UXO Lao has conducted interview of new potential staff including deputy chief of operation and procurement staff. Deputy Chief of operation is a new position and procurement staff will be replacing the old staff who contract was terminated.
