2. Progress Reporting

Please summarize the main achievements during the project cycle:

With short-terms funds allocated by UNDP COVID-19 Rapid Response Facility, UNDP Turkmenistan effectively supported the implementation of Turkmenistan's Immediate Socio-Economic Response Plan to Acute Infectious Disease Pandemic. In this work, within the 6-month period, UNDP Turkmenistan designed and carried out activities that contributed to 1) strengthening the national health system's response to COVID-19 and 2) provision of targeted support to the most-affected vulnerable groups of the population as part of the UN-Turkmenistan joint effort to mitigate the negative impact of the global pandemic on the socio-economic situation in Turkmenistan with particular focus on the most vulnerable groups in line with the principle of "leaving no one behind" and SDG 1, SDG 3 and SDG 17.

Project Output 1

As part of the first strand of work, UNDP engaged with the Ministry of Health of Turkmenistan for provision of consultancy services that resulted in updating Turkmenistan's Comprehensive Action Plan for sanitary protection of the etrap/city territory from the outbreak and spread of especially dangerous and quarantine diseases. At the same time, drawing on its advanced procurement architecture, UNDP procured eight disinfectant skid sprayers with eight trailers for the sanitary-epidemiological service of Turkmenistan to support the national response to pandemic.



Project Output 2

Under the second strand of work, UNDP Turkmenistan supported the national effort to expand outreach to vulnerable and insecure people to build their COVID-19 resilience and recovery by providing essential




social aid. To this effect, based on the rapid scan findings, <u>UNDP procured and delivered</u> 13690 food and hygiene parcels and 40500 facemasks to 7940 people from the most-affected vulnerable groups of the population (low-income families, children with special needs, people with disabilities, single mothers of many children, lone elderly people). In this work, <u>UNDP used the networks of major local CSOs</u> for distribution of life-saving social aid in all five regions of Turkmenistan and the capital city Ashgabat, thus not only reaching out to vulnerable populations but also testing and strengthening the CSOs financial and organizational capacities to respond to crises such

as the global pandemic.

The rapid scan of vulnerabilities informed UNDP of the concerns, anxieties and challenges facing vulnerable groups in the times of pandemic and provided recommendations to all interested stakeholders for the further action. The rapid scan findings will be used further as an advocacy resource to stimulate government's attention to the social sector and developing new initiatives on mitigating the social and economic impact of the



pandemic. The rapid scan findings were shared with interested UN agencies in Turkmenistan for the further analysis and reference in work



Along with social aid provision, UNDP supported the nation-wide awareness raising campaign against the pandemic by providing the Ministry of Health with funds for printing 5000 information booklets on COVID-19 awareness and prevention measures that were distributed among the most-affected vulnerable groups of the population.

4. Lessons learned and follow-up steps (if applicable)

- The rapid scan assessment mechanism proved to be useful for identification of vulnerabilities of the population and provision of recommendations for the further action.
- Promoting the implementation of the RRF project as one of the activities of Turkmenistan's Immediate Socio-Economic Response Plan to Acute Infectious Disease Pandemic, thus raising the status and importance of the project activities in the national context.
- In the time of pandemic, the most urgent needs of vulnerable populations are best served by local CSOs that proved to be very efficient in mobilizing internal resources for social aid distribution among the most-affected vulnerable groups of the population.
- Although officially supported by the government and incorporated into Turkmenistan's Immediate Socio-Economic Response Plan to Acute Infectious Disease Pandemic, the governmental bureaucracy in matters requiring quick decision making coupled with certain sensitivities in relation to accepting external emergency aid caused some disruptions in the delivery of social aid to the target audiences, thus prompting UNDP and CSOs partners to look for alternative solutions of reaching out to vulnerable groups of the population.
