Brief Description

The objective of the project is to promote climate-smart urban development. By a challenge prize approach, it seeks to actively engage the local self-governments, civil society, public and business communities, research institutions to come up with new and innovative ideas on how to contribute to this in practice and to jointly develop, finance and implement these ideas further.

In 2022, funds will be used to support open data innovative solutions proposed by cities, namely Kragujevac, Kraljevo and Krusevac. Moreover, funds will be used to support a project proposed by the City Municipality of Stari grad and one proposed by the Public Company Regional Landfill Duboko Uzice.

The project supports the Ministry in reviewing the Programme for sludge management, necessary by laws and analysis for closing landfills in Serbia.

Funds for 2022 will be used for developing social and economic impact analyses of supported innovative solutions.

Focus in 2022 will be on continuing promotional activities and organizing the final conference.
