Brief Description

This initiative represents a framework package of support to the MPALSG, focusing on selected priority areas of assistance to the MPALSG, also leaving room for responding to requests for expert and operational support on an ad-hoc basis. The AWP for 2017 responds to such a request and provides additional funding through introducing a new output for proving support to the IT Council of the Government of Serbia, whereby the MPALSG mandate has been expanded to include professional, technical and administrative tasks for the needs of the IT Council*. Priority areas to be tackled by Output 1 focus on several aspects of the MPALSG's mandate according to the Law on Ministries: implementation of systemic laws and implementation of the Strategy for Public Administration Reform and its Action Plan as well as strengthening coordination between central and local level of government. Output 2 will support the IT Council in implementing its Plan of Priority Activities through support for IT training courses, construction works at the Faculty of Electronic Engineering in Nis and the Faculty of Organizational Sciences, promotion of digital literacy and coaching.
