Programme Objectives	The MRF Programme aims to facilitate the transition from Humanitarian Response to Sustainable Development. It pays special attention to women and vulnerable groups, including those displaced from the conflict situation, by promoting the involvement of the most vulnerable and affected population in immediate economic opportunities, enabling them to self-sustain their individual incomes while improving community-led activities.

Current Status of Mozambique Recovery Facilities Activities

- In these first three months of implementation of the activities 53,143 families were planned to be reached; 39,707 (75% of total planned households) have been identified; of which 20,181 are female-headed households. Within the identified families; 3,120 families are headed by the elderly and 5,420 families headed by people with disabilities;
- With active engagement and participation of affected families, the following income generation activities were prioritized for their recovery: small business, carpet making, sewing; hairdressing; carpentry, poultry farming, agriculture, milling, reforestation and fruit trees plantation, livestock, fish farming, beekeeping, agro processing, solar power for businesses, sawmilling, mechanics, bricklaying and plumbing
- To date, 14,576 families have been assisted under the MRF programme (37% of the families identified), of which 8,425 are women-headed households. Within the assisted families 1,363 are headed by the elderly and 1,444 are headed by people with disabilities.
- Through temporary the temporary employment the community productive infrastructure and social spaces rehabilitated includes: clearing of waste contaminated community spaces; refurbishment of markets, rehabilitation and cleaning of drainage ditches, opening of access roads, opening of water boreholes; construction of shades for production and multiplication of plants; collection of waste, opening of fish ponds, manufacturing of bricks, construction of improved stoves, construction of cattle and goat handling facilities, construction of small bridges, and construction of latrines.
- Regarding starter-up support, 10,854 kits were delivered for various income generating and small business initiatives to 9,666 beneficiaries, 1,799 of whom are women.
- In order to strengthen the beneficiaries' knowledge and skills in developing their small business initiatives, 5,744 beneficiaries were trained, 2,711 are women.
- Of the payments resulting from the temporary work, households, mainly female-headed households have formed groups and started to make savings. By now 133 savings groups have been created, where 2,562 were women; these groups have saved 1,370,244.00 MZN in total, 1,079,520.00 MZN has been lent and 229,195.00MZN remains in cash.

Savane, Dondo District

In Savane Resettlement Area, the following activities were realized;

- Together with partner Adel Sofala from July until then 4, 000 families have been identified (where of these 3200 are families headed by women);
- Of these families, 1600 families have benefited from some assistance, 1280 of which are families headed by women;
- These families were involved in various temporary work activities, such as the construction of a fish pond; cleaning of agricultural fields, opening of access roads and construction of improved stoves where with the money earned 92 groups were created, with a total of 2,694 members, of which 1,894 are women, where they saved 1,271,160.00 MZN; of this amount 1,048,320.00 MZN was lent among the members and remains in cash 222,840.00 MZN;
- Start up Kits were delivered according to the table below 1, 500 Kits for various initiatives of income generation and small business activities to 1600 beneficiaries.
