3. Reason revision is being requested.

- Delayed start of implementation by the project responsible partners in pilot regions due to lack of fuel in the country.
- Recruitment of the project staff was challenging due to the short timeline of the project duration (SC contracts can't be issued for the less than 6 months).
- Delayed funding of the JP on 1 month in fact caused delay the assessment of IDPs shelters' accessibility and their needs in equipment and relevant delay with procurement of equipment, delay in revision of the existing humanitarian programme document on children with disabilities.
- Long own procurement procedures for medical equipment (expected ca. 5 months from TOR to delivery).
- Due to internal displacement, difficulties in identification of parents organizations of children with disabilities to ensure participatory assessment of situation of IDP families with children with disabilities.
- some delays with the Advocacy campaign (for key providers, key referrals) due to the time required for the involvement of discussion-makers and key stakeholders and to ensure the campaign is efficient and targeted
- More time required/delays ongoing with the population awareness campaign (for increasing demands, rights for SRH services and availability of services) to ensure messaging is in-line with target audience
- Difficulties and delay with delivering of equipment caused by complication of its logistic incl. transportation in war period.
- Challenging implementation across expanding humanitarian response (extension of the Flash Appeal in July).
- Anticipated slow-down in activities during winter/holiday/reporting period.

No change to the activities. Delayed activities just shifted for 3-4 months in the workplan.
