Based on the outcomes of the first phase of the Project;

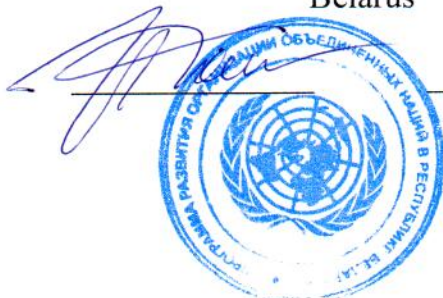
In compliance with the need for sustainable and effective assistance to the Republic of Belarus in implementation of Sustainable Development Goals,

Agreed as follows:

1. Parties extend the implementation period of the Project in a format of the second phase till 7 February 2019 (inclusive) with no changes to the Project goal and objectives stated in the Project Document.
2. The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) finance the second phase of the Project to the total amount of US\$80,000.
3. The second phase of the Project is implemented in line with the Project Document, the current Memorandum and attached the detailed Work Plan of the second phase of the Project.
